A GUIDE TO BLUE BAG RECYCLING

BLUE BAG RECYCLABLES

The following items can be placed in a blue bag for pick up:

PAPER

- Newspaper & inserts
- Magazines & catalogues
- Writing & computer paper
- Christmas cards; non-foil gift wrap
- Paper Egg Cartons
- Phone books

PLASTIC (please clean & dry)

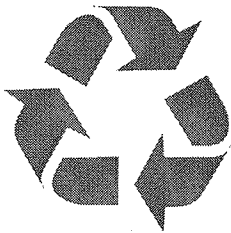
- Household cleaner bottles
- Pop & beverage bottles
- Milk jugs
- Plastic bags
- Margarine & yogurt containers
- Detergent & fabric softener bottles

CARDBOARD

- Flattened corrugated cardboard boxes
- Flattened cereal & food boxes (remove liners)
- Juice boxes
- Flattened milk cartons
- Flattened shoe boxes & brown paper bags

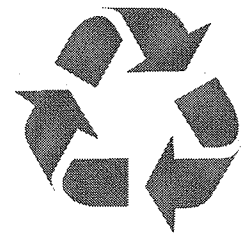
METAL (empty & clean, labels OK) (no loose lids; trap inside can or discard)

- Clean tin cans (ie. soup, juice, etc.)
- Aluminum containers (ie. pie plates)
- Aluminum can (beverages)
- Empty non-hazardous aerosol cans



GLASS (empty & clean, labels OK)

- Jars (ie. pickle, jam, etc.)
- Bottles (ie. ketchup, beverages, etc.)



Items NOT ALLOWED in blue bags

- Diapers
- Styrofoam
- Ceramics
- Mirrors
- Plate Glass

Please take note of the following:

- If there is garbage in your blue bag, the whole bag will be rejected.
- Items placed in blue bags can be mixed; you do not have to separate the items.
- All items placed in blue bags must be clean and dry.
