ALLOWED:

PAPER

Newspaper, writing paper, Christmas cards, egg cartons, phone books etc.

CARDBOARD

Flattened boxes, cereal boxes, juice boxes, milk cartons, shoe boxes, paper bags etc

PLASTIC (clean and dry)

Cleaner bottles, pop and beverage bottles, milk jugs, plastic bags, margarine containers etc.

METAL (clean and empty, labels ok)

Tin cans, aluminum containers, empty aerosol cans etc.

GLASS (clean and empty, labels ok)

Jars, bottles etc.

NOT ALLOWED:

Diapers, Styrofoam, ceramics, mirrors and plate glass.

No need to sort, all items may be in the same bag, any unacceptable garbage seen in a bag, the whole bag will be rejected!
