There are some things about the new season we would like to pass on to you:

1. REGISTRATION NIGHTS – these will be Monday March 15th, Tuesday March 16th and Wednesday March 17th from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. These are the same nights as the Parent-Teacher Interviews are held at either Millet School or Griffiths-Scott School. Look for our signs at the School when you are attending for your child’s interview. To save time for you on that night, we are attaching a Registration Form so you can print as many copies as you need and fill them out before going to one of the Schools to get registered.
2. MILLET SOCCER TOURNAMENT – although the usual Millet Days Fair / Parade is being put back until later in the summer this year, our Soccer Tournament will continue to be held on the same Farmer’s Day weekend as it always has been. This year, the dates are Friday June 13th to Sunday June 15th.
3. PAUL PAY FIELDS (U6, U8 and U10) – as many of you will realize, these fields have become very dry, bare and patchy with the lack of rain over the past few years. Good News!! We are putting in irrigation this spring so the younger kids should have much better fields to play on this year.
4. PARENTS OF U6, U8 AND U10 CHILDREN – Millet Soccer Association plans to re-focus a lot of our effort on these younger age groups this year. Like most parents in Canada, you probably didn’t play soccer when you were young and you probably don’t think you can help your own children much – not true! We would love to see all parents get more involved with their own kids while they learn the game. The game has simple rules, and a little extra help from each parent at this early age can really help their kid(s) learn the game. We will put on a Course for all parents to learn what they need to know for helping their kids learn and play this great, and very popular, sport.
