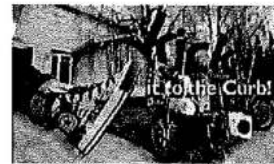
The Town wants to reassure residents that we will be working diligently to ensure all operations of the Town are up-to-date during this transition.
