## **NEW PROPOSED LAND USE BYLAW 2018/11**

The Public Hearing for Land Use Bylaw 2018/11 is scheduled for Nov. 28. A draft of the proposed Land Use Bylaw may be examined on our website or at the Town of Millet Administration Office until Nov. 28th. Please submit any comments prior to the Public Hearing by 4:30 pm on the day of the Public Hearing.

## **CANNABIS RETAIL SALES - Proposed Part 8, Section 8.24**

The Federal Government regulates all aspects of cannabis production and medical cannabis sales, while the Provincial Government regulates non-medical cannabis sales, licensing, minimum age, public consumption, safety (production of minors) and enforcement.

1. A retail cannabis store may not be located within 100 meters of: a provincial health care facility, a school or a parcel of land designated as school reserve.
2. Only one retail cannabis store will be allowed at any given time within each of the following districts listed below;
  - C1-Downtown Commercial
  - C2-Highway Commercial
  - M-Industrial
  - IN-Industrial
