REGULATIONS FOR INSTALLATION OF WATER METERS FOR PROPERTY OWNERS & PLUMBING CONTRACTORS

BYLAW # 2012/12

SECTION 3

2a) Every meter installed on any service by the Town shall remain the property of the Town and is installed on the understanding that all owners, tenant or occupiers shall give every facility for the introduction, placing, inspection and reading of such meter; and shall protect it from interference or injury by frost and shall be liable for all costs incurred to replace said meter.

SECTION 5

- a) Before any construction, water shall be metered. After any construction, reconstruction, alteration or change, or the completion of any work requiring a permit, water shall not be turned on to any building or premises until after the whole of the work has been done to the satisfaction of the water department. Water shall be turned on or off only by an authorized employee of the Town.
- b) Where water is turned off and on for the purpose of construction, alteration or change, such work shall only be done upon authorization of the Town.
- c) When construction water is required for any building under construction, the Town shall be notified 24 hours prior to the turning on of water.

PLUMBING LINES REQUIRED

Residential plumbing lines are 3/4" copper lines with 3/4" fittings.

Public Works requires 1 ' of space around the water meter to complete the installation.

Commercial plumbing lines are between 3/4" - 2" copper lines depending on the volume of water flow.
