The meeting was called to order by Mayor Wadsworth at 6:00 P.M.

Diane Wyllie-Oulette was in attendance to express her objection to the purchase, by the Town of Millet, of the old Millet School. She strongly feels that this should be brought to plebiscite and allow the taxpayers to have a say. She is worried that, due to the age of the building, there will be substantial costs involved in fixing it and does not want to see taxpayers burdened with these expenses. She also stated she feels we should be concentrating on attracting business to Millet and that she felt there was not enough incentive for businesses in our community. She cited one example that she knew of personally whereby a distillery wanting to locate in the Town had been rejected. Ms. Wyllie-Oulette also added that she has never had any complaints with the amazing job the town does with snow removal each year.

Mayor Wadsworth stated that the Town has been very diligent in the overall process and have acquired advice from 3 professionals and had the building thoroughly inspected. He also stated that in the 33 years he has resided in Millet he has never been so excited about the future growth of the Town, with the upcoming residential development and the annexed lands for industrial growth, he foresees a huge change in the future of our Town.
