1.0 CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Wadsworth at 3:01 p.m.

2.0 <u>PUBLIC HEARINGS</u>:

2.1 Bylaw 2020-19 being an amendment to the Land Use Bylaw 2018-11

Mayor Wadsworth opened this Public Hearing at 3:02 p.m.

Mayor Wadsworth stated that the purpose of this Public Hearing was to provide the public with the opportunity to provide their comments on Bylaw 2020-19, being an amendment to the Land Use Bylaw 2018-11 to amend the age requirement of manufactured home units within the RMP – Manufactured Home Park District. The Development Officer provided Confirmation of Notice that the Public Hearing was placed on the www.millet.ca website to allow ample time for residents to view the proposed Bylaw.

Notice of the Public Hearing was also placed in the August 26th and September 2nd editions of the Wetaskiwin Times.

The Legislative Assistant was asked to confirm and read aloud three written submissions that have been received at the Town Office from the following;

- Chris Inkster
- Laurie Danis
- Terry Petersen

The Development Officer read aloud one additional written submission that had been received by her from an anonymous writer.

Mayor Wadsworth asked a first time for any persons wishing to be heard.

Terry Petersen stated that the new proposed Bylaw referred only to homes being brought into the Park that would need to comply with the Park's stated acceptable standards.

Dave Horner stated he was a former Executive Director of the Manufactured Housing Association of Alberta and that the age stated in the proposed Bylaw of 1992 is inaccurate as the code requirements changed in 1984/85.

Laurie Danis reiterated her concerns verbally as per her written statement submission over the new proposed Bylaw.

David Diduch indicated his support for the proposed change in allowing homes older than 5 years to be brought into the Manufactured Home Park so long as they were maintained to the standards that the Park Owner (Chris Inkster) had assured in his written statement.

Mayor Wadsworth asked again for any persons wishing to be heard (second time).

Shannon Kuzio stated her concern that if her home were to sell, because it is older would the new owners need to move it out of the Mobile Home Park because of the age not conforming to the new proposed Bylaw? The Development Officer confirmed that existing homes in the park are grandfathered.

Mayor Wadsworth asked again for any persons wishing to be heard (third time).

Hearing none, Mayor Wadsworth closed the Public Hearing at 3:28 p.m.

2.2 Bylaw 2020-20 being an amendment to the Land Use Bylaw 2018-11

Mayor Wadsworth opened the second Public Hearing at 3:29 p.m.

Mayor Wadsworth stated the purpose of the second Public Hearing was to provide the public with the opportunity to provide their comments on Bylaw 2020-20, being an amendment to the Land Use Bylaw 2018-11 to add the R3A – Medium Density Residential Small Lot District and reclassify Plan 2021501, Block 2, Lot 34.

The Development Officer provided Confirmation of Notice that the Public Hearing was placed on the www.millet.ca website to allow ample time for residents to view the proposed Bylaw.

Notice of the Public Hearing was also placed in the August 26th and September 2nd editions of the Wetaskiwin Times.
