SOME REMINDERS FROM ENFORCEMENT SERVICES...

In the Town of Millet, all dogs six (6) months or older must be licensed. Licensing your dog is not only easy to do, but the license identifies you as the pet's owner in the event your pet gets lost. Being able to identify your pet makes reuniting you both much easier. The fee for a lifetime dog license is \$80.00 and can be obtained at the Town of Millet Administration Office located at 5120 50 Street.

Millet Enforcement Services investigates and enforces violations of the Animal Control Bylaw as outlined in Bylaw #2018-06. Your assistance in ensuring your dog is licensed in the month of March 2020 is greatly appreciated. After March 31, 2020 if a license has not been issued, dog owner(s) will be subject to fines. Additionally, Enforcement Services will be enforcing any person with a dog not attached to or being held by a leash.

With spring approaching, and in the coming months, please ensure to keep back alleys free of debris and trees trimmed. Now is the time, while trees are still in the dormant state and you can see the branches, to remove and properly dispose of the black knot before it infects neighbouring trees.
