



## **PARKS, RECREATION AND FACILITIES SEASONAL EMPLOYEES**

The Town of Millet is hiring Seasonal Employees from May 1, 2022 to August 31, 2022 to perform a variety of tasks related to the operation and maintenance of municipal parks and recreation as well as facilities.

### **Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Perform manual tasks to ensure the Town's parks and recreation facilities are maintained to a high standard including but not limited to:
  - Weeding, cutting grass, trimming, emptying garbage receptacles, collecting garbage, painting, and routine inspections of equipment and facilities.
- Learn the safe operation of equipment such as trimmers, lawnmowers
- Follow safety guidelines to keep self and others safe on the worksite.

### **Working Hours:**

- 80 hours per two-week period, typically day shifts
- Evening and weekend shifts may be necessary occasionally

### **Position Requirements:**

- Must have a criminal record check, and driving abstract meeting the standard established by the Town
- Must be able to qualify for the Canada Summer Job grant
- Excellent customer service skills
- Minimum Grade 10 education
- Class 5 drivers license
- First Aid Certificate would be an asset
- Candidates must be able to work in a variety of weather conditions and lift 40 pounds.
- Previous experience with equipment including lawn mower, trimmer, drills, etc would be considered an asset.
