

WATER RATIONING



During May to September of each year, all residents are required to practice water conservation for outdoor

watering. Properties ending in an odd number may water on odd numbered days only and properties ending with an even number may water on even numbered days only.

The 2022 Tax and Assessment notices are May/beginning of June. Remember that the deadline for tax payment, without penalty, is June 30, 2022. An 18% penalty will be added on July 14th for any unpaid taxes. Anyone that was on the pre-authorized payment plan last year DOES NOT need to reapply. If you would like to sign up for the 2023 plan, you must do so PRIOR to April 15, 2023.


LAGOON SITE
