Thank you, Susie 😊

Dear Millet Town Council,

Hello!

I am proposing that the town of Millet grant my bootcamp classes the opportunity to utilize the community hall at the same cost as we were renting the community hall in previous years.

My bootcamp classes have been running in Millet for over 10 years. It is a very small group that ranges from 3-10 people depending on the day. It is one of the only fitness opportunities for our small community and to be honest, it is barely for profit. I do this class because I love our community and I want to be able to contribute to the health and wellness of every person within our community, no matter what their fitness level or ability, by giving them the opportunity to participate in these local classes.

If I have to pay for 2 hours of a rental for the community hall, I may unfortunately not be able to keep the class running as it's not feasible with the varying amount of people committed.

For our classes in previous years at the community hall, we were graciously granted the opportunity to utilize the hall at a one-hour cost and then last year it was a one-and-a-half-hour cost of \$25/hr on weekdays and \$30/hr on the weekends and the two-hour minimum was waived. This is greatly appreciated, as I stated earlier, it is a small local business and class sizes can vary greatly.

We appreciate the opportunity to have our fitness classes in Millet as well as the support from the town and community and we hope you will consider our proposal!
