Analysis:

Overall taxes receivables balance has decreased due to our 2 and 3 years arrear balances decreasing. However, we have seen an increase in current and one year in arrears over last year. This indicates that a higher number of tax payers are struggling with paying their taxes compared to previous years. However, there is not enough time to know if this is a cause for concern.




