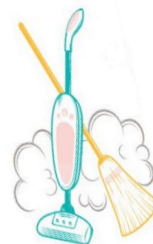
### TAX DEADLINE

The 2025 Tax and Assessment notices are scheduled to go out at the end of May/beginning of June. **Remember that the deadline for tax payment, without penalty, is July 15, 2025.** Unpaid tax penalty dates and amounts are as follows: July 16, 2025 (8%), October 16, 2025 (6%) and January 16, 2026 (16%). Anyone that is on the pre-authorized payment plan last year does not need to reapply. If you would like to sign up for the 2026 plan, you must do so prior to April 15, 2026.

### GARBAGE/RECYCLING/ORGANIC CONCERNS

If you have questions or concerns about garbage, recycling or organics (wasn't collected, cart was damaged, etc.), please contact **Integrity Waste Solutions Inc** directly at **780-437-5000**. For missed collections, they have asked that residents allow them the FULL scheduled day for collection (in case of late in the day collections) and to phone in the following day.

### WATER RATIONING

From May to September of each year, all residents are required to practice water conservation for outdoor watering. Properties ending with odd number may water on odd numbered days only & properties ending with an even number may water on even numbered days only.

We are thrilled to announce that the Town of Millet's new mass notification system is now officially live! This advanced platform is designed to keep you informed and connected with the latest updates and critical information for the Town of Millet.

### What Makes It Better?

**Instant Alerts:** Stay updated with real-time notifications about emergencies, weather updates, and essential public safety information.

**Multiple Channels:** Choose your preferred communication method—email, voice call, text message, or voice call on your cell phone—or select all four, ensuring you never miss an important update.

For Residents **who do not** have access to the internet please come to the office and we will assist you in signing up in the system and you will receive alerts via cell phone (voice or text) land Line (voice only).

For residents **who do** have access to the internet please go to the Town of Millet website and go to the Residents Tab and then Mass Notification (<https://www.millet.ca/residents/emergency-notification>) and complete the registration.

**\* When creating a profile, please remember to put your PHYSICAL ADDRESS (not only your PO Box number) in so that you receive alerts for your area.**
