A reminder to residents that when an Alarm System generates more than two False Alarms within a calendar year, the owner will be liable for a fine, as follows:

| 1) For a third false alarm call within one calendar year | \$150.00 |
| 2) For a fourth false alarm call within one calendar year | \$250.00 |
| 3) For a fifth and subsequent false alarm within one calendar year | \$500.00 |

Please ensure you are reaching out to your alarm company if your system is generating false alarms frequently and have it adjusted.

This advanced platform is designed to keep you informed and connected with the latest updates and critical information for the Town of Millet.

What Makes It Better?

Instant Alerts: Stay updated with real-time notifications about emergencies, weather updates, and essential public safety information.

Multiple Channels: Choose your preferred communication method—email, voice call, text message, or voice call on your cell phone—or select all four, ensuring you never miss an important update.

For Residents **who do not** have access to the internet please come to the office and we will assist you in signing up in the system and you will receive alerts via cell phone (voice or text) land Line (voice only).
